PLEASE HAVE YOUR VEHICLE PARKING PASS CLEARLY DISPLAYED IN YOUR WINDSCREEN BEFORE YOU ENTER THE COUNTRYFILE LIVE CAR PARKS. YOUR PASS SHOULD REMAIN VISIBLE WHILST PARKED.

YOU CAN PARK IN ANY EVENT CAR PARK AS DIRECTED. YOUR PARKING PASS DOES NOT GIVE YOU ACCESS TO A SPECIFIC CAR PARK.

SAT NAVS

We strongly advise you do not use a Sat Nav system, as they do not take into consideration our traffic management system. As you approach the estate please follow the AA event signage marked: Countryfile Live Public. These will guide you into the parking areas and our Traffic Marshalls will direct you.



There will be plenty of parking spaces to use at Countryfile Live so please **do not** park on verges, in gateways or on private roads as your vehicle will be towed away.

VISITOR ACCESSIBILTY

For accessible parking for blue badge holders or those who have Event Mobility equipment bookings, please follow the wheelchair symbols on the AA event signage.


